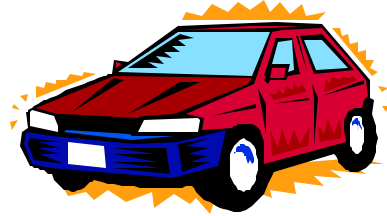
Enrollment Update
